

Biography for Sendhil Mullainathan

Sendhil Mullainathan has been Assistant Professor in the Department of Economics at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology since 1998, where he teaches courses in corporate finance, economics and psychology and macroeconomics. He completed his PhD at Harvard University in 1998. He also serves as a Faculty Research Fellow at the National Bureau of Economic Research. His research in corporate finance revolves around issues of corporate governance, transparency and executive compensation. He has also researched models of psychology and economics and families in South Africa. Currently, he serves as a consultant to the Harvard Institute for International Development for a project on privatization of Tamil Nadu's public sector undertakings.
